ASSEMBLY

Bälinge village, 14 km upstream from Luleå town centre, on the south side of the Luleälv river.

TRAVEL INSTRUCTIONS

Separate travel instructions explain how to reach the event. Please read these carefully as there are roadworks which affect the connecting roads to the event.

PARKING

Distance from parking to arena 200 m, fee 20 SEK.

There is a shared entrance and exit to the car park. This means that traffic coming in will have priority before the event and traffic leaving will have priority after the event. Note that if you only intend to drop off runners please do not drive into the car park. The location of a marked drop-off point is given in the Travel Instructions.

SILVA LEAGUE-SPECIFIC INFORMATION

START LOTTING

Start lotting takes place on Thursday 22/5 as per SOFT's instructions for the Silva League.

START LISTS

Lists will be posted on Eventor and www.luletrippeln.nu once lotting is complete as well as at quarantine, start and in the arena.

PRE-RACE RETIRALS

Runners no longer intending to run should inform the organiser by 10 am on Saturday 24/5 at the latest. Up until 23/5 notification should be sent to jan-ola.lindberg@telia.com Thereafter via tel. +46 (0)70 559 06 26.

PLACING OF RESERVES

No placing of reserves will take place as all runners are automatically allotted in the main classes.

RUNNER REGISTRATION

Silva League runners should register at the Silva League information point in the arena for checking-off, issue of number bibs, final details and GPS vests (if required).

NUMBER BIBS

To be worn by all Silva League runners. These can be collected at the SL information point in the arena. Please bring your own safety-pins. Numbers are to be worn on the chest unfolded and fully visible.

Numbers as per the following sequence:

Competitors representing non-Swedish clubs will not be able to collect their number bibs unless their entry fees have been paid.

GPS

A list of runners who are to wear GPS tracking devices will be posted on Eventor and in the arena. Vests are to be collected from the information point in the arena in good time before start. The GPS unit is collected at the start max 20 minutes before start time. Runners choosing not to wear an allocated GPS unit will be disqualified.

In accordance with IOF rules, GPS devices with a display are not permitted to be used in classes with WRE-status, HD21E.

RENTED SI CARDS

Can be collected from the entry on the day registration in the arena.

QUARANTINE LISTS

Approx. 30 runners from HD20E and 60 runners from HD21E will require to enter a quarantine on the way to the start. A list will be published on Eventor and www.luletrippeln.nu on Friday 23/5 as well as being posted in the arena and at the quarantine.

QUARANTINE

Approx 30 runners from HD20E and 60 runners from HD21E will require to go via quarantine on the way to the start. A list will be published on Eventor and www.luletrippeln.nu on Friday 23/5 as well as being posted in the arena and at the quarantine.

Entry to the quarantine opens at 12.00 and closes at 13.00. Runners on the quarantine list who have not been checked-off by this time will, as with runners who after entering the quarantine leave without permission to go anywhere else than the start, will not be allowed to compete..

Distance from arena to quarantine: 600 m. Follow orange/white tapes to start 1.

The quarantine is outdoors with access to toilets and drinking water.

Telecommunications equipment may not be used in the quarantine (e.g. internet, telephone).

Distance from quarantine to start 1300 m, orange/white tapes..

START 1

Distance from arena to start 1: ~1900 m, orange/white tapes.

A warm-up area (350 m) is available close to the start.

Toilets and drinking water are available at the start.

TRANSPORT OF BAGS AND CLOTHING

Bags will be transported by the organisers from the quarantine to the finish. Vehicle trailers for transporting the bags will be parked at the exit to the start. Bags will not be marked by the organisers.

Other clothing will be transported by the organisers from the start to the event arena.

LATE START

Register late arrival at the start and follow the marshal's instructions.

START PROCEDURE

3 min before start: Call-up and start list check-off

2 min before start: Control descriptions are made available

1 min before start: Move forward to start line

At start: take map and follow tapes to start control.

CLASSES AND COURSE LENGTHS

For all classes, course length and shortest possible running distance are the same.

ESTIMATED WINNING TIME

The winning time is estimated to between 33 and 35 minutes for all classes.

WARM-DOWN

In the indicated area in the arena.

LULETRIPPELN-SPECIFIC INFORMATION

FIRST START

11.00

ENTRY ON THE DAY

At the arena between 10.00 and 11.30. Starts for open classes (Öppna klasser), INSK and U classes from 11.00 to 12.00.

RENTAL OF SI CARD

This can be done at a cost of 30 SEK at the same time as entry on the day registration. Non-return or loss of an SI card will incur a charge of 330 SEK. Payment for runners who do not belong to a club or runners from non-Swedish clubs should be made at registration. For members of Swedish clubs, fees will be invoiced after the event.

START 2

All other classes, i.e. no E classes or classes with start 3.

Approx. 400 m from the arena. Follow orange/blue tapes.

No clothing transfer. Runners should make their own arrangements.

There are no toilets provided at this start.

START 3

HD10, HD12, INSK, U1, U2, Ö (open) classes

Close to the arena, orange/yellow tapes.

Note: the road to the car park crosses the competition area for runners at start 3. Both runners and car drivers should take care.

LATE START

Register late arrival at the start and follow the marshal's instructions.

MARKED PATHS AND ROUTES

In the early part of the courses from start 3, paths have been marked in the terrain using white tape to distinguish them from animal tracks that are present in the area.

The easier courses follow an unclear path on the way to the last control. This path has been marked using white tape.

Taped routes marked with a dashed violet line on the map are marked with white tape in the terrain.

GENERAL INFORMATION

TERRAIN DESCRIPTION

Forest crossed by two forest roads. Mainly detailed terrain but with areas lacking in obvious features. The entire area is almost completely free of "gridline" features.

Moderately hilly with very detailed slopes.

Runnability is very good on the open rock surfaces but more limited in regions of denser woodland and rock-strewn terrain. Vegetation consists of mature deciduous woodland along with pockets of younger birch and pine.

Printed on the map. Loose descriptions available at the start, max 5 x 14 cm.





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GENERAL INFORMATION (CONT'D)

CONTROLS/PUNCHING SYSTEM

Controls are marked with an orange/white kite, control code, two SI units and a pin-punch.

In parts of the competition area controls lie very close to each other. Runners are advised to pay extra attention to the control codes.

Control posts with kite and control code for Sunday's event are placed in the forest. SI units are not fitted on these posts. These use different control codes from today's event.

FINISH

Finish and recording of time are coupled to punching of the finish control. All competitors then proceed to download and the return of GPS units.

MAXIMUM TIME

120 minutes.

DRINKS

Vatten erbjuds efter målgång, samt för SL-löparna vid karantän och start.

RESULTS

Preliminary results will be posted in the arena. Final results will be published at www.luletrippeln.nu and on Eventor after the event.

PRIZEGIVING

For Silva League classes the ceremony and prizegiving will take place at the finish at 2.45 pm. Prizes to the leading 5 competitors in each class.

Runners in INSK and U classes will receive prizes as they finish.

The number of prizes and time for prizegiving for HD10-HD16 will be posted in the arena.

In all other classes, prizes will be awarded to the winner. A number of prizes will also be lotted out. Winners have their prizegiving directly after the SL classes. A list of winners of lotted prizes will be posted in the arena. Prizes can be collected from the server.

MINIKNAT / STRING COURSE

In the arena. Starts from 10.00 to 11.00, 20 SEK per entry.

CHILDMINDING

Childminding is not available as it had not been requested.

FOOD AND DRINK

Opens at 09.00, offering pasta salad, hamburgers, hot and cold drinks, cakes and sweets. Milk-free and gluten-free alternatives will be available.

FIRST AID

First Aid is available in the arena. They have contact with control marshals and are able to collect injured runners from the forest.

For other healthcare issues, please contact the on-duty service at Stadsvikens vårdcentral (Stadsvikens Health Centre) in Luleå.

SHOWERS AND TOILETS

Warmed outdoor showers close to the arena.

Toilets are available as follows: 10 in the arena, 3 at quarantine, 3 at Start 1 and 2 at the showers.

SPORTS EQUIPMENT TRADERS

Keltamäki, www.keltamaki.com will be selling orienteering equipment in the arena. Cash payment only.

PRESS

COMPETITION RULES

These event details apply for all competitors.

For all SL competitors, additional rules set out in "Förutsättningar för SL 2014" also apply.

For classes HD21 the "IOF Foot Orienteering Competition Rules 2014" apply with additions as per the "Guidelines for WRE 2012".

For HD18/20 the applicable regulations can be found in SOFT's "Tävlingsregler för orientering v 2.0"

PROTESTS

Registration of all protests should be made at the protest/complaints point in the event office.

Verbal or written registration of complaints or protests with respect to HD18/20 should be submitted as soon as possible but at the latest 2 hours after the end of the competition.

Written registration of complaints with respect to HD21 should be submitted as soon as possible but at the latest 2 hours after the end of the competition.

Written protests with respect to HD21E shall be submitted at the latest 15 minutes after registration of complaint.
