Arena/Directions	Myrestad's shooting range, about 4 km northwest of Brösarp. https://maps.app.goo.gl/9evrvT3GsSju4SdS7 Coordinates 55°44'33.0"N 14°05'35.9"E Directions from highway 19 just north of Brösarp. Distance from the parking lot to the arena max 700 meters. See separate arena map
Start	<ul> <li>All classes orange/white markings.</li> <li>Evening 1: 1500 meters.</li> <li>Evening 2: 600 meters.</li> <li>Evening 3: 900 meters.</li> <li>First start 17.30. Late registrants start first in their class. Full coverage clothing is mandatory. Clothing inspections will be made.</li> <li>Control descriptions are available separately and printed on the front of the map. Overalls are transported back to the arena after the last start.</li> <li>Toilets are available at the start.</li> </ul>
Maximum time	1,5 hrs.
Open classes/ Induction	Start between 17.30 and 19.30. Registration between 17.00 and 19.10 at the arena. For course lengths and levels of difficulty, see the announcement when registering.
Shadowing	Shadowing of participants is allowed in all open classes. However, not before your own race in competition class.
Punching system	SportIdent.
Race bibs	Competitors in D14, H14, D21 and H21 shall wear race bib. The race bib should be used for all 3 races. Self service of race bibs at the start of race 1.
Read out	Reading takes place immediately after the finish at the secretariat at the arena. Everyone must read their badge after the finish, even if the race is not completed. Rented SI badges are returned immediately upon reading.
Trail marking	<b>Evening 1.</b> There are routes marked with white markings for classes D10, H10, White 2,0 and White 4,0.
	<b>Evening 2.</b> The course is a combination of medium and long-distance character for the very longest courses. There is a marked distance between two checkpoints in classes D10, H10, Introductory 2,0, White 2,0, White 4,0 and Yellow 2,5. There are also some paths that are marked with white markings.
	<b>Evening 3.</b> There are routes marked with white markings for classes D10, H10, Introductory 2,0, White 2,0 and White 4,0.

Terrain description	Forest terrain with continuous roads, paths and stone walls with slopes that are partly poor in detail, as well as good visibility and accessibility. Mostly moderately hilly terrain except on the longer tracks on stages 1 and 2 which will have steeper slopes. Areas with dense forest and undergrowth that prevents running are marked on the map. Towers for hunting are not reliable objects as they can be moved around. The dense tree crowns of the beech forest, combined with late start time, may be reasons for having a simpler headlamp as a map light.
Local map signs	<ul> <li>Black cross is either a collapsed tower or a bench.</li> <li>Green cross is rootstock/tree stump, at least 1,5 m high.</li> </ul>
Forbidden areas	Forbidden areas marked on the map.
Toilets	Toilets at the arena, and several toilets between the parking lot and the arena.
Shower	Hot showers at the arena.
Water	Available at arena after reading
Food service	Well stocked refreshments are available at the arena.
Sports sales	At the arena, SM Sport.
Child care/ Mini Knat	From 17.00 at the arena.
Emergency number	Indicated on the map, Tel: 0703–075386
First aid	At the arena or via emergency numbers.
Wildlife report	Report immediately after reading at the report table.
Pricing	Price in stages in youth classes subject to participants. Prize to the overall winners in the competition classes DH18 and older after three evenings. Prize for all participants in the Induction 2,0 and White 2,0.
Startup fees	Participants from foreign clubs shall pay their entry fee before 17.00 at the direct registration before the start of stage 1.
