





Bulletin 2 – Final Details Silva League and World Ranking Event Sprint distance - April 26 2014

(Ver 1, 2014-04-21) Supplementary information or late changes may apply and it is the responsibility of the competitor to take note of final detail posted at the arena and the quarantine on the competition day.

Venue The sports center Drivan in Båstad. GPS coordinates N56.4240, E12.8550. NOTE!

> Only entrance from exit 39, E6-E20 to quarantine for the Elite runners after 09.00 am. See in particular traffic PM for Silva League and Elite classes. The

quarantine opens 08.00 am.

Parking Walking distance from parking to quarantine is maximum 400 m. Buses parks

> at the same area as cars, but shall be pre-notified to silvaleague@hahol.se. Caravans are not allowed at the parking area. No parking fee is charged.

Quarantine/registration Runners in main classes, W21 Elite 1, M21 Elite 1, D20E1, H20E1, D18E1 and H18E1, must be in the guarantine no later than 11.00 am. Runners in classes E2 and E3 must be in the guarantine no later than 09.30 am. Registration takes place at the entrance to the quarantine. Runners representing foreign clubs must have paid the entry fee to be able to register. Participants who are coming late to the quarantine are denied to start.

> There will be access to toilettes and drinking water and also some refreshments and sports equipment for sale.

Use of any device that enables online information about the competition is strictly prohibited in the quarantine. It is not permitted for elite runners to use any social media, such as Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, etc. after finish until 14.30.

Coaches who have visited the arena are not allowed to enter the quarantine.

Number bibs

Runners in classes W21 Elite 1, M21 Elite 1, D20E1, H20E1, D18E1 and H18E1 will receive their number bibs and safety pins after signing in.

Start number bibs shall be worn on the chest, and may not be folded.

Changing Changing will be possible in the quarantine.

Clothing and bags Bags from the quarantine and spare clothing from the start will be transported

to the arena. Submit to the designated location at quarantine and start area.

Pre-start/Start First start 10:00 am in all E2 and E3 classes.

First start in Elite 1 classes as follows: D20E1/H20E1 11:30 W21 Elite 1/M21 Elite 1 12:10 D18E1/H18E1 13:20

Late start is not allowed.

The way to start is marked with orange/white tapes. Distance from quarantine to pre-start is 600 m. The SI-card must be cleared and checked by punching the "Töm" and "Check" units at the pre-start. Distance from pre-start to start is 225 m.

Start procedure At the start area;

3 minutes before start time: Roll call and tick off

2 minutes before start time: Control description obtained 1 minute before start time: Lineup at the starting line

Start time: Receive map and start

GPS-tracking List of runners selected for GPS-tracking will be announced in the quarantine, at

the arena and the Silva League Information at the arena. It will be approx 25 runners in W21 Elite 1 and M21 Elite 1. The equipment is handed out at the entrance to the quarantine. Runners refusing to wear the GPS device do not have permission to start. The GPS equipment shall be returned directly after the finish.

Clothing No requirement to wear full body cover.

Terrain description Flat to moderately hilly urban environment. The ground will be 90% asphalt or

paved surfaces and 10% greensward.

Map Båstad Centrum. Scale 1:4 000, contour interval 2,5 m. Drawn by Maths

Carlsson, 2013-2014 according to sprint standards. Color laser printed map, delivered in a plastic pocket. Cannons, phone boxes, advertising- and infor-

mation signs are marked with X on the map.

Extra fences There are some extra fences in the area which will be marked at the map as the

symbol for non passable fence.

Walls and cliffs There is a large number of walls both passable and non passable, and also

some passable cliffs. For clarifying the differences, the non passable walls are

drawn with 0,47 mm line and the passable cliffs with 0,30 mm line.

Control descriptions Control descriptions are printed on the map. Separate control descriptions are

also available in the start lanes. Maximum size is 50x190 mm.

Punching system/control points

The SportIdent punching system is used. Own SI-card number shall be submitted with entry, otherwise a rental SI-card will be provided with additional charge (SEK 25). Participant who do not return the rental card will be charged SEK 250. Rented cards are handed out at the entrance to the quarantine. Clearing of SI-card occurs at the pre-start. SI-card of types 5 and 8 are not allowed.

2770 m

Control points are marked with orange/white flags. Each control point has at

least two SI units and a needle punch.

2930 m

Forbidden areas Private property and other map symbols that are forbidden to pass according

to sprint standards. Blue/yellow tape defines some other forbidden areas.

Some major roads are marked as forbidden areas on the map. Sidewalks on both sides are permitted to use. Use tunnels, which will be marked on the map,

to cross the roads. Also the area around the harbor is out-of-bounds.

Expected winning time About 13 min and 30 sec in all Elite classes.

Maximum running time 60 minutes

Cool down area There will be a designated area for cool down jogging, instructions are availa-

ble after finish.

Drop outs Runners in the Elite 1-classes who cannot attend the competition, have to

notify the organizer as soon as possible, until Friday 18.00 to e-mail:

Reserve runner allocation

Start lists will be published online on silvaleague.hghol.se and Eventor on Friday 25th April. Reserve lists for DH20E1 and DH18E1 will be published at the same time. No allocation of reserve runners will be done in the WRE-classes,

W21E and M21E.

Allocation of reserve runners will be held at the entrance to the quarantine, Saturday 26th April 9.30 am. Selection is done according to the reserve list and to claim a place the competitor must attend in person or be represented by a team leader.









Results Results will be published through Eventor as soon as possible after the compe-

tition is completed.

Competition rules The competition is governed by Swedish Orienteering Federation (SOFT)

competitions rules and regulations. International Orienteering Federation (IOF)

standards are used to distribute the World Ranking Event scores.

Arena Båstad Tennis stadium. Runners in all Elite classes are not allowed to visit the

arena before start. Walking distance from quarantine to arena is 2300 m. By car it is 1900 m from quarantine to parking area, and then 400 m walking

to the arena. See separate information about the traffic and parking.

Embargoed areas The area is already embargoed at http://silvaleague.hghol.se/avlysning/.

It is not permitted to stay in the embargoed area during 09.00 am to 14.30 on the competition day, except for the marked way to the showers after finish.

Showers Heated indoor showers. Walking distance 1400 m, follow signs and tapes.

Do not disturb runners when crossing their course.

Toilets Toilets are located in several places at the arena, and also in the quarantine.

Medical care Basic medical care directly adjacent to the finish.

Services Kiosk with a limited range of drinks, sandwiches, pastries and sweets.

Pre-booked field lunch is served between 12.00-15.00. Meal tickets are distributed to each club from the Silva League Information at the arena.

Children's string course is available at the arena between 9.00 and 10.45 am.

Child care is not available.

Prize giving ceremony Prize giving ceremony will be held at the stage adjacent to the speaker, about

15 minutes after last prize winner's finish in Elite 1.
