Event venue

Rute, northern Gotland

Assembly Area

Road 148 from Visby. Turn right after 45 km toward Lergrav. Guidance with kites from Rd 148. Distance Visby – Assembly Area 50 km.

Payment with card, SEK (Swedish crown) or Euro. Coins are not accepted.

Parking and parking fee:

SEK 50 for three days (cash) paid directly to the parking officials.

In the parking area there is a ruin of an old mill. The ruin is marked as forbidden area with a blue/yellow ribbon. There is a **HIGH RISK FOR ACCIDENTS** in the ruin so we kindly ask you to respect the restriction.

Distances

Parking – Assembly Area: maximum 150 meter

Assembly Area – Start:

Day 1: 700 meter Day 2: 700 meter Day 3: 350 meter

Terrain description

Mostly low growing pine forest with some spruce and broad-leaved trees.
Shrubs are limiting the visibility to a varying degree.

No hills but old, relatively apparent sea banks.

Mostly good availability but there are areas with dense and sometimes thorny shrubs.

Start

First ordinary start at 10.00 am all three days.

For Open (ÖM1-9) and beginners (Inskolning, U1, U2) classes the starting time is optional between 09.30 and 12.00 all days.

Day 3 chasing start for all classes except W/M10, W/M12, W/M12K and W/M14K which have timed start.

Latest registration time for Open classes is 11.45 am.

Clothing dump and lost items

Coveralls from Start and found items will be placed by the notice board in the Assembly Area.

Maximum run times

Day 1 and 2: 2 hrs, Day 3: 2,5 hrs

Chasing start day 3

Separate PM for chasing start routine will be posted at the notice board in the Assembly Area and in Eventor. Starting times for leaders in each class will be posted at the Assembly Area on Day 2.

Final, completed start lists including course lengths for the chasing start day 3 will be posted soon after the day 2 competitions have ended. They will also be found at www.visborgsok.se and in Eventor the same evening.

Bibs

Bibs should be worn day 1 and 2 by **M/W 21E**, **M/W 20E** and **M/W 18E**, see startlist for number. Same bib both days. Self service of bibs at the Start. See also separate PM for chasing start day 3.

Miniknat – competition for the youngest

Taped course for the youngest with start 09.30-12.00 all days. Fee SEK 30/day in cash. Information about Miniknat is posted in the Assembly Area.

Entry On the Day (EOD)

Entry On the Day registration to beginners (Inskolning, U1, U2) and Open (ÖM1-9) classes is done in the secretariat tent. These classes make three one-day competitions. Payment in cash.

Fees: SEK 75/day för Inskolning, U1, U2 and youngsters up until 16 yrs in Open classes. SEK 130/day for remaining Open classes.

If you registered via Eventor you can go straight to the starting place. EODs must register **before 11.45**. Optional starting time 09.30-12.00. Don't forget to start punsch!

Maps for Open classes are available in the Information tent.

Shadowing

Shadowing before your own run may only occur in the Beginners classes (Inskolning, U1, U2) and Open 1. After shadowing you may not enter W/M10-16 or rank qualifying classes. Shadowing maps are available.

Drinks

Drinks are available in the terrain during stage 3 (locations marked on the map) and at the Start day 1 and 2. Water is available at the Finish all days.

Prize-winners in beginners classes (Inskolning, U1, U2) and Miniknat receive their prizes directly at Finish.
