Welcome to Havs-OL day 2 Järnavik the 9th of july 2017

After registration Via Eventor at a 50 % increased fee until Wednesday the 5th of July 20.00.

Last-minute-registry. Available on the day of the competition at the expedition before 09.30am at a 100 % increased fee, as long as there are maps in stock.

Meeting place Järnaviks camping.

Road description Take the exit From the E22 at the interchange Bräkne-Hoby nr 55, from there, it's about 6 km to Järnavik. Follow the official road signs toward Järnavik – Tjärö.

Parking Parking at Järnaviks camping, from there, it's about 500 meters to the arena.

Merges H20 → H21K

Cancelled classes The following classes have been cancelled, due to a lack of participants, and are therefore not available for any late registrations: H17-20K, D16K, D14K, D12K.

For start 1, follow the orange/white marking 1600 meters, be aware that the road is trafficked.

D16, H16, D18, H18, D17-20K, H17-20K, D20, H20, D21, H21, D21K, H21K, D35, H35, D40, H40, D45, H45, H50, H55, H60, H65, ÖM8 and ÖM9.

For start 2 follow the orange/blue marking 350 meters.

D10, H10, D12, H12, D12K, H12K, D14, H14, D14K, H14K, D16K, H16K, D50, D55, D60, D65, D70, H70, D75, H75, D80, H80, D85, H85, H90, Inskolning, U1, U2, ÖM1, ÖM2, ÖM3, ÖM4, ÖM5, ÖM6, ÖM7 and HittaUt.

Foreign competitors pay the competition fee in cash at the expedition on the day of the competition.

Rules SOFT:s competition rule set applies.

Map Järnavik, made 2013, briefly revised 2017 according to the swedish standard in effect before 2017-07-01.

Scale 1:7500 for DH60 and older classes, 1:10 000 for everyone else. Equidistance 5 meters.

Terrain information very detailed moderately hilly coastal terrain containing a few smaller parts with big differences in height. The terrain is very diverse ranging from beech forests to open rock ground surfaces to pine forests to the rocky hills along the coast.

Unclear paths

DH12, DH14K, ÖM2, ÖM3 and ÖM4 all have unclear paths between at least 2 controls, which are marked white.

Fences There are barbed wire fences, if they are marked by 2 parallel lines on the map they are not allowed to be passed.

You are allowed to pass the fences if there are paths going through them or if a crossing is marked on the map.

If you notice any stone walls or fences that have been damaged, please report it when you're finished competing

Grazing cows there will be cows in a limited area of the competition.

Sportident. Wait for both the sound and light signal to register.

Pin terminals are used as a reserve if the electronic terminal is not working. The competitors are encouraged to make sure their SI-number given on the start list is correct. Rental Sportident cards are available at the expedition at a cost of 30kr, which will be invoiced after the competition. If you lose a rented Sportident card you will be charged a fee of 500kr. Remember to reset the Sportident before you start!

Control descriptions Available loose, printed on the maps for the classes using the maps with the scale 1:10 000.

No control descriptions printed on maps for D60 and older, H70 and older and ÖM7.

Clothing Fully covering clothing is required according to SOFT's rules.

Ticks Make sure to check yourself for ticks after you're finished competing, as there are a lot of them in the area.

Number tags Number tags are for the classes DH12-16, self catering at the start, read your number on the start list.

Water station There will be a water station at start 1 as well as the finish.

Passageway for all the competitors starting at start 1 there will be a control next to a trafficked road followed by a red/white marking about 80 meters leading up to a passageway through a privately owned plot.

Overalls Transport for overalls will be available from start 1 to the arena.

Open classes ÖM1, ÖM2, ÖM3, ÖM4, ÖM5, ÖM6, ÖM7, ÖM8, ÖM9, Inskolning, U1 and U2. Registration at the arena between 09.00am – 11.00am. Starts between 10.00am – 11.30am.

More information available on a separate memo.

Maxtime 2,5 hours.

Wild animals If you spot any moose, deer or wild boars, please report at the expedition.

Kids course Free starts on the arena between 09.00am och 11.30am. Please, bring your own SI-card if you have one available, you are allowed to use the same one as in the competition.

Child care Available on the arena between 09.00am and 01.00pm.

Toilets Toilets are available at the arena, as well as start 1.

Changing room/showers Warm water showers are available near the parking, about 500 meters from the arena.

Food/cafeteria Cafeteria connected to the camping serving various different dishes etc. Will also be hosting music/entertainment during the Saturday evening.

Awards ceremony The prize table will be available for the winners from day 1.

Trophies and merchandize prizes for the youth classes. The adults will be part of a raffle for gift cards. Open classes will be part of raffles for merchandize.
