description	
Terrain	Forest with a few different hilly areas. Many paths and ski trails crosses the area. Moderate to very hilly with elements of detailed downhills. Partially poor detailed and flat terrain. Mostly good passability and visibility. Clearcuts in different ages, some young forest that is partly thinned with branches on the ground.
Start bibs	For all participants, self-service at start (Sunday at Info board). Note! Different bibs every day. Please re-use your safety pins given Friday.
Start	Empty and check your SI-card at start, be sure to be at start at least 4 min before starting time.







Results	Will be published at result board continuously and published at website when competition is finished. Protests shall be handed to Chief of Competition within 30 minutes after final results have been published for each class.
Gun inspection	Every day. Participants only allowed at shooting range during their race. Bring your bib to get your weapon by shooting staff after finished race.
Adjustment shooting	Lead by Chief of Shooting. At paper panels, lane distribution list published at Info board and shooting range.
Weapon handling	At all-time, the weapon must be carried in the barrel, the barrel pointing upwards. After finished adjustment shooting put your weapon in weapon racks according to bib number, bolt open. Shooting staff will close bolts and blind fired all weapons after adjustment shooting. No spare ammunitions allowed outside shooting range in clips or at weapon.
Medical	Available at RA.
Toilets	At RA and at start for classic distance. No toilet at start for Sprint distance.
Shower	Indoor at RA. Please keep in mind that there are many participants and limited amount of hot water.
Lunches	Food tickets will be handed out Thursday at Team leader meeting. Lunches served at RA between 11.00 and 14.00, bring your ticket.
Canteen	Drinks, sandwiches etc. available at RA. Pay cash in SEK or by Swish
Banquet	At Event Arena Sidsjön (EA) at 18.30 Saturday gathering 18.15, bring your food ticket!
