Classes

W21E, M21E, D20E, H20E, D18E and H18E

Depending on the number of participants, the elite classes will be divided into Elite 2 and Elite 3 in accordance with regulations for World Ranking Events and Swedish League. The estimated winning time is W21E/M21E 90-95 minutes, D20E/H20E 70-75 minutes, D18E/H18E 55-60 minutes.

Punching System

Sportident. SI-card 5, 6, 8, 9, 10, 11, Comcard, SIAC (not touch free) can be used. Notify SI-number when you register. SI-cards may be hired for 30 SEK/day. There will be a charge of 400 SEK for a lost SI-card.

The clear (töm) and check units are on the way to the start. Controls consist of two aluminum control stands. All controls are marked with a flag and 2 Sportident units with control code number. It is the runner's responsibility to ensure that the control unit gives a sound and light signal as a confirmation of punching.

Entry Fee payment

Please note, WRE runners must register their IOF number in Swedish Eventor for the result to be reported to IOF.

Arena

Arena and arena plan, see Arena map in Eventor or at the Arena.

Assembly Area

Klåverödsgården, Klåveröd, [GPS: 56.034092, 13.163571](https://www.google.com/maps/place/56.034092,13.163571). Signposts from the following roads: Ljungbyhed-Stenestad, Kågeröd-Stenestad and from road 109 east of Knutstorp.

Parking

Most cars will park close to the Arena. Distance Parking – Arena 150-800 meters.

Buses must be announced in advance to: orientering@oksilva.nu no later than Tuesday 10 April.

Camping

Is allowed very close to the parking area in Klåveröd, see Camping PM at Eventor.

Quarantine

No quarantine. Competitors may visit the Arena before start.

Start

Start 1: W21E, M21E, D20E, H20E, D18E and H18E. Distance Arena - Start, **2200 m**, follow orange/white markings. First start for WRE/Swedish League classes at **10:00**.

Start 2: Elite2 and Elite3 classes and all spectator race classes. Distance Arena – Start **200 m**, follow orange/blue markings. First start at **11:00**.

Warm-up course

Map with warm-up course, 700 m is provided for runners on the way to start 1. Follow orange/white markings 1150 m to “warm-up” start. End of warm-up course is located 200 m before pre-start. Runners are not allowed to leave the “warm-up” map area.

Pre-start

Pre-start is located 200 m before start. Toilets and drinking water is available at pre-start. **10 minutes** before start will there be a verification of number bib (front) and SI card. Runner will then continue to start.

Clothing

Participants can leave clothing at pre-start. Clothing will be transported back to the Arena and placed close to the shower area. No transport from Start 2.

Leaders

May follow runner to pre-start, but not to start. Leaders must follow the orange/white marking back to the arena.

Start procedure

3 minutes before start - check-in with verification.

2 minutes before start - separate control description available.

1 minute before start - entering the map area.

At start time - Runner receive the map.

Late start arrival

Competitors who are late to start should be allowed to start as soon as possible, however, with as little impact as possible on other contestants. Competitor shall contact officials and follow instructions.



GPS Units	25 runners in W21E1 and M21E1 will wear a GPS unit. The runners selected for GPS tracking will be announced at the arena and on Eventor. Vests for the GPS units will be handed out in the information tent at the arena. Different sizes are available. The GPS unit will be given to the runner at pre-start. Runner that refuse to wear the GPS unit are not allowed to start. The equipment has to be returned at the finish area.
Maps W21E and M21E	There are two map variants at start for classes W21E and M21E. Runners with odd start number (1,3,5,etc., 101,103,105,etc.) shall take variant A . Runners with even start number (2,4,6,etc., 102,104,106,etc.) shall take variant B . Both maps and separate control descriptions are marked A respective B at start. Please follow signs and officials instructions at start.
Map change	The courses for classes M21E and W21E are in two parts. Competitors in these classes get their course in two parts by the start. Reverse the map at the end of the first part.
Refreshments	Water is available at marked places in the forest. For W21E and M21E will there also be water available at one control where runners will visit more than once.
Max Running Time	The maximum running time is 150 minutes for all classes.
Arena Route	Runners in W21E, M21E, D20E, H20E, D18E and H18E will have a course route through the arena.
Finish	Notice that all Elite class participants have a separate finish . Make sure you choose the correct one.
Red Exit	Competitors who do not complete their course must still go to the administration and check out.
Map	Klåveröd-Skärålid, scale 1:15 000, 5 m contours. Drawn in 2017 by Kenneth Kajsajuntti. The map is offset printed.
Terrain Description	Moderate to heavily hilly terrain, mainly forest (beech, pine) with a few small areas of cultural landscape. Mainly good accessibility. Forest roads and paths are more common in some areas. Very varied terrain, from detailed rock and cliff areas to slope areas and marshes with few details. Courses are to a large extent going through Söderåsen National Park.
Embargoed Area	The embargoed area cannot be visited until after competitions. Map with Embargoed area can be found in www.slskane2018.se and Eventor.
Out of Bounds	Private property and areas marked on the map are out of bounds. Anyone seen entering areas that are out-of-bounds may be disqualified.
Control Description	Control descriptions are printed on the map, they are also available at the start as separate control description sheets. Be careful to check the numbers of your controls when you punch.
Bibs	Number bibs will be handed out by self-service at the pre-start. Bibs must be worn on the chest and must not be folded or cut in anyway, see start list for your number. Number bibs series: M21E 1-100 W21E 101-200 H20E 201-300 D20E 301-400 H18E 401-500 D18E 501-600



Results & online	The results will be posted at the Arena and on Eventor. The map and the courses will be posted on Livelox (www.livelox.com). The competitions can be followed online, see links at www.slskane2018.se/Liveresultat/ and Eventor.
Prizes & ceremonies	The contest is opened at 09.55 in the Arena. There will be prizes in the Swedish League classes. The number of prize winners in each class will be displayed on the results board. Prize ceremonies will take place approximately 20 minutes after last runner in elite classes has finished. Prizes that are not collected go to the organizers.
Sports sales	Pölder Sport, www.polder.se at the Arena.
Showers	Heated outdoor showers in the Event Arena.
Toilets	At the Arena and pre-start for Start 1, see Arena Map at Eventor and at the Arena.
First Aid	Smaller injuries can be handled by medical staff at the Arena. The emergency number in Sweden is 112.
Refreshments	There will be a cafeteria at the Arena with a selection of food: sandwiches, hamburgers, sausages, drinks, etc. Gluten and lactose free alternatives. Payment: cash (SEK or Euro, exchange money only in SEK) or Swish 123 042 55 53 (Rävetofta OK).
Childcare	Organized child care at the arena.
Miniknat	There is a string course at the arena with free starting time from 10.30-12.30.
Spectator race	National Long distance race will take place at the same Arena from 11:00-. See separate PM at Eventor or at the Arena.
Competition Rules	SOFT's competition rules including rules for Swedish League & IOF World Ranking. All competitors shall wear clothing covering the whole body except for head, neck and arms.
