





On behalf of the Swedish Orienteering Federation, Kristinehamn's Orienteering Club invites to Swedish Championships in PreO and in TempO Saturday September 29, 2018

The competition day begins with the PreO competition at 9:30 AM, followed by the TempO competition in the afternoon. The same venue for both competitions, Kristinehamn OK's club house "Hultet".

We recommend combining these competitions with OK Tyr's PreO competition on Sunday 30 September. This competition will take place in Skoghall, approximately 50 km from Kristinehamn.

moderate hills, varying degree of details and visibility. The course follows well prepared tracks of very good quality but some slopes may occur, both upwards and downwards.

Open courses: Open A (without "zero" controls)

Course length: Approx. 1000 m

Start: *N.B. Changed time* - First start preliminary at 13:00 for the B-

class directly followed by the A-class. The Elite class is planned to start approx. 14:30 Same starting order as on PreO in each

class. Distance to start approximately 500 m.

Map: Scale 1: 4000, contour interval 5 m, mapped according to ISOM

2000.

Terrain: Normal Scandinavian terrain, mostly pine and spruce forest with

moderate hills, varying degree of details and visibility. The course follows prepared trails of good to very good quality but

some slopes may occur, both upwards and downwards.
