



## Final information spectators' race – Värmlandsdubbeln

### Long distance, Sunday April 14<sup>th</sup> 2019

### Host: Säffle municipality

<b>Elite classes</b>	For specific information about World Ranking Event and Swedish League, see final information on Swedish Eventor or at the arena.
<b>Location</b>	Tallmossen. Directions from E18 between Knöstad and Segmon. GPS: 59.247787, 12.937463. See arena map on Eventor home page.
<b>Parking</b>	Distance from car park to arena 100 – 1 000 m. Parking fee 20 SEK.  No overnight parking for mobile homes and minibuses. Those wanting to camp should see the event homepage for information about camping alternatives nearby.
<b>Start</b>	First ordinary start 10:00. (Late entries start before first ordinary start.)  Start 1: elite classes. 1 100 m, orange/white tapes.  Start 2: HD14 – HD75, H80, Open 5 – 9. 1 900 m road, orange/blue tapes.  Start 3: D80, HD85, HD10, HD12, HD12K, HD14K, Introductory class and development 1 – 2, Open 1, 3 and 4. 600 m road, orange/yellow tapes.  Competitors in classes HD10 – HD16 are allowed to read their maps for one minute before they start.
<b>Late start</b>	Competitors who arrive late to their start must inform event officials and follow their instructions.
<b>Warm up clothing</b>	Extra clothing can be left at the start and will be transported back to the arena by event officials.
<b>Control descriptions</b>	Control descriptions are provided on paper at the start and are also printed on the map.

**Map** Daltjärn. Scale 1:15 000 for HD16, HD18, HD20, HD21, HD17-20K, HD21K; 1:7 500 for HD60 and older and Open 7; other classes 1:10 000. Contour interval 5m. Digital printing. New map produced in 2018 by Jerker Boman and Kalle Engblom.

Local symbol: **O** - Charcoal burning ground.

**Terrain description** Undulating to hilly forest with many details and mostly extremely good runability. The upper parts of the hills are covered in pine forest which in places is very thin.

There are relatively few felled or thinned areas and not many areas with thick vegetation. Some slopes have lines of cliffs but apart from that the ground is not too rocky. Blueberry bushes are the dominant form of undergrowth. There are a small number of marshes.

There are few paths or roads in the competition area.

**Indistinct path** There is an indistinct path which is most relevant for youth classes up to 14 years and introductory/development classes. The path is marked with white tapes in the forest and purple on the map.

**Punching system** SPORTident. All types of SI-Card can be used. If the card number is not specified when entering then the competitor will be given a hire card at a cost of 30 SEK. If the card is not returned after the competition then there will be a charge of 400 SEK.

**Controls** Metal stake with orange/white kite and one punching unit. In some parts of the competition terrain, there are many controls in a small area. Be careful to check your control code to avoid mispunching.

**Open classes** It is possible to enter open, introductory and development classes at the arena between 09:30 – 12:00.

It is also possible to enter the competition classes HD10 before 11.00 without the extra fee for late entry.

Choose your own start time for open, introductory and development classes. Times are available from 10:00 to 12:30. Don't forget to start-punch!

Competitors who are not members of a Swedish club must pay at the entries desk.

<b>Entry fees</b>	<p>Under 17: 80 SEK  17 and over: 170 SEK  Hire of SPORTident card: 30 SEK.</p> <p>Swedish clubs will be billed after the event. Competitors not representing Swedish clubs must have paid in order to be allowed to start. Prior to the event, payment can be made to  IBAN: SE87 8000 0815 6294 3535 0211. BIC/SWIFT: SWEDSESS  Specify name, club, day and class when making payment.  Recipient: Skattkärrs SOK.  Payment on the day can be made at the entries desk by bank card or cash in SEK or Euro (change can only be given in SEK).</p>
<b>Map collection</b>	No collection of maps from the spectators' race.
<b>Results &amp; Online reporting</b>	<p>Results will be published at the arena and on the Swedish Eventor homepage. Live results and commentator soundtrack will be available via <a href="http://live.orientering.se">http://live.orientering.se</a>. Courses will be published on Livelox after the race.</p>
<b>Shadowing</b>	Shadowing of inexperienced orienteers is allowed, as long as the shadower is not competing in an elite class.
<b>Toilets</b>	Toilets at the arena and on the way to start 1 and 2.
<b>Shower</b>	Changing/warm showers are located about 500 m from the arena.
<b>Cafeteria</b>	A good selection of wraps, fruit, sandwiches, coffee, tea, chocolate, soft drinks, cakes, sausages and hamburgers. Pay in cash, MasterCard/Visa or the Swedish mobile phone payment system Swish (123 521 5082), in SEK or euros.
<b>Field lunch</b>	To guarantee getting a field lunch, it should be ordered in Eventor by 19.00 on the 10 <sup>th</sup> April. See Eventor for menu – a vegan alternative is provided each day.
<b>First aid</b>	There is a first aid tent in the arena with doctor and nurses. For life-threatening situations ring 112 and contact the nearest event official.
<b>Sport shop</b>	Pölder sport, <a href="http://www.polder.se">www.polder.se</a> , in the arena.
<b>Wild animal report</b>	If you meet an elk or deer in the forest then this should be reported to the event officials – there is a desk for this outside the finish area.
<b>Max time</b>	3 hours.
<b>Children's course</b>	09:00 – 12:00. Cost 20 SEK.
<b>Crèche</b>	Beside the arena. Children must be at least two years old.
<b>Opening ceremony</b>	Opening ceremony with representative from Säfte municipality at 08:45.

**Prize-giving**

Prizes to everyone in youth classes up to 14, including introductory and development classes. Introductory and development classes collect their prizes at the finish. The number of prizes in classes HD16-21 will be displayed on the result list. Prizes to the winners of other classes. A lottery will be used for prizes in open classes. Prize-giving's will take place at various times – the commentator will inform when prize-giving's are about to take place.
