Quarantine

Indoor at Fisksätra school, see map. Opens at 8:30. All runners shall register at the quarantine no later than 10:50 when the quarantine closes. Coaches may support their athletes in the quarantine but need to obey to the same quarantine rules and if they leave the quarantine, they are not permitted to re-enter.

Technologies that allow you to follow the competition live or otherwise obtain information about the race is not allowed in the quarantine.

Basic coffee bar and orienteering equipment for purchase available at the quarantine.

Cancellation

Reserve runners

No replacements will be made in WM21

Allocation of replacement positions will be made at the Arena at the Race Office at 09.00. Competitors who are not present at the time of allocation of replacement positions cannot claim the right for the position, regardless of the reason for not being present. Runner may, however, have a representative making the claim if not present in person.

Responsible for the allocation of replacement positions is SOFT and IOF event adviser Bo Månsson.

Bib number

Competition numbers are obtained at the check in at the quarantine. Runners bib number is provided in the start list.

Classes and number series:

W21 1-100 M21 101-200 D20E 201-300 H20E 301-400 D18E 401-500 H18E 501-600

Bring your own safety pin to attach the bib number to your clothes.

E2/E3 do not wear bib numbers.







GPS-units

Selected runners will be asked to carry GPS-units by the event organizer. A list of competitors who shall wear GPS-units will be published on the Swedish Eventor web site. Vest and GPS-unit shall be collected at the Pre-start.

It is the responsibility of the runner to collect the GPS-unit ahead of the start time.

GPS-unit and vest should be returned to the organizer after checking out at the Race Office.

Warm up map

For Elite 1-classes (W21, M21, D20 E, H20 E, D18 E, H18 E) there will be a warm up map over a small area on the way to the Prestart. Sign or marking indicate when you enter this area. Map is provided in the quarantine.

Luggage

Luggage can be dropped off at a designated area between the quarantine and Pre-start. The Luggage shall be marked with name, class, club, telephone number and competition number (for those that carry competition number). The luggage will be transported to the arena and should be picked up after the race.

Warm up clothes

Warm up clothes are dropped off at the Pre-start (Skogsö) and at the start (Erstavik).

Toilets ahead of the race

WCs at the quarantine Start 1: 4 toilets at Prestart Start 1.

Start 2: 8 toilets at Start 2.

Start 1

Orange/white markings, from quarantine to start.

2,39 km from quarantine to start, sub distances as follows:

1,99 km from quarantine to Pre-start. 400 m between Pre-start and start.

870 m to warm up area from quarantine on way to the Pre-start.

700 m from warm up to Pre-start

Crossing a rail way on the way to the Pre-start. Please admit extra time in

the event of a train passing by.

Start 2

Orange/blue markings from Arena. 2,55 km from Arena to start.

Start procedure

8 min ahead of start: Pre-start roll call.

Jog to start.

3 min before start: Check-in with verification

2 min before start: Separate control description available

1 min before start: Entering the map area

Late start arrival

Competitors who are late for start will be allowed to start as soon as possible, however, with as little impact as possible on other contestants. No time compensation will be made to the runner. Competitor shall contact officials and follow instructions.

Start list

Start list is published at Eventor as soon as the results from Swedish League #4 Sprint are concluded and the start order is official, in the evening of the 3rd of May.



Competition Area Skogsö

Terrain description Skogsö

Hilly forest and meadow areas with mostly good runnability. The upper parts of the hills are covered in pine forest which provides good runnability. Slopes/heights are moderate to steep. The competition area is close to recreation and urban development and has therefore several tracks.

Please note that the competition area is preserved by the local community. Your respect is appreciated.

Out-of-bounds Areas Skogsö

Private property and areas marked on the map are out-of-bounds. Some boundaries are marked with blue/yellow markers.

The cemetary is out-of-bound.

Map change Skogsö

The courses on Skogsö are divided into two parts and two maps. Both maps are provided at start, exposed on different sides of the map case. The first map is clearly marked; W21 (1), H20 Elit (1) etc. The runner







World Ranking Event changes maps where the course part (1) ends. The starting point on map (2) is the same position as the last control on map (1). The second map is marked W21 (2), H 20 Elite (2) etc.

Shore side walk Skogsö

Towards the end of the courses, competitors will follow markers between two controls. This route is partly on pontoons on the water, partly on a recently established wharf anchored to the ground. Runners are requested to be extra careful to avoid accidents.

Competition Area Erstavik

Terrain description

Moderately hilly terrain with good runnability on the hills. Reduced runnability between the hills. The terrain includes both wild forest and areas in close proximity to developed areas.

Marked tracks At the start of many courses, a track is marked with white markers to

improve visibility of the track for beginners/easy courses.

Out-of-bounds areas

A wildlife zone is printed on the map as out-of-bound area and marked

with continuous yellow/blue markers. This zone is forbidden to enter.

All parts of the golf course are out-of-bound area.

The circular road around Fisksätra residential area is out-of-band and

forbidden to enter.

Towards Fisksätra All courses have a long running leg through Fisksätra residential area.

We ask you to be observant to cyclists and the public as you pass

sidewalks and cycle lanes.

Control descriptions Printed on the map and separately available at start.

The size of the control description W21 = 155x43mm, M21 = 170X43mm

Punching system Sportident SI-card 5, 6, 8, 9, 10, 11 and SIAC are permitted. SI-number

shall be provided at registration. No Touch-free.

Control model Orange/white kite on stand or wooden small ladder with dual punching

units. The control points are sometimes close to each other. Pay attention

to the code number to avoid mispunching.

Refreshments Water is at the Pre-start (Skogsö), and at the start (Erstavik) respectively.

For Elite classes, water also available on the course, and after finish.

Clothes Competitors' clothing must fully cover the body, except for the head, neck

and arms, according to SOFT's competition rules.

Competition rules SOFTs competition rules apply including rules for Swedish League & IOF

World Ranking Event, plus this Bulletin.

Max time 90 minutes.

Non FinishRunners not completing the coarse or by other means have not passed

the finish line must go to the Race Office and check out.
