

PM - ESKILSTUNA WEEKEND 5-7 juli 2019

The event is a straight three-day competition with combined total time giving the final result. Chasing start on day 3 for classes HD21, HD20 and HD18

First regular start

Stage 1: 6 p.m. Stage 2 and 3: 11 a.m.

Location/Arena

The arena forall 3 days is at Sundshändö Signposted from road55 between Strängnäs (24 km) and Malmköping (8km).

Parking

Parking is on grass verges.

Distance from parking to arena: 100-300 m.

Parking fee with parking pass: 70 SEKfor the three days. Passes can be purchased at the car parking on day 1.

Cost of parking without parking pass: 30 SEK/day.

Camper vans and caravans are primarily referred to the event camping at Åsborgen, Ärla. There is access to showers and toilets around the clock. Specially designated places are available for camper vans wishing to remain in the arena with the services offered during the competition.

NOTE! both SEK 400 and the SEK 70 parking fee are to be paid.

After consulting with the landowner and road community, "wild camping" in the competition area and along the entrance road from road 55 is discouraged.

Open classes and Inskolning.

Seven open classes, Inskolning, U1 and U2. Details of course distances are given in a separate document. This will be available on Eventor and in the arena.

Entries open one hour before the first start.

Stage 1: 5.50 - 7.30 p.m.

Stage 2 and 3: 10.50 - 12.30 a.m.

Fees for Open classes: Adults 150 SEK, 16 years and younger 80 SEK.

Maps for "shadowers" are available for Inskolning and U-classes on all 3 days.

Cancelled classes

H90, D85, D90

Clothing

Full leg cover is required. Short-sleeved tops are permitted.

Punching system

SportIdent is used for all classes.

If you do have not have your own SI pin, these may be rented at a cost of 90 SEK for all three days. If you have not given a number when registering, you will be allocated a rental pin.

For open classes the cost is 30 SEK/day.

SI types 5-11 can be used.

Rented SI pinsshould be returned at thefinish. Lost SI pins will be charged at a cost of 600 SEK.

Distance to start, all classes:

Day 1 and 2 100 m. Day 3: 900m.

Marked with orange-white tape.

Drinks

Available at the finish on each day.

Competitors in HD18-21 and courses longer than 6 km will have access to water at locations indicated on the map or on the control definitions.

Start times

Inskolning and U-classes and all open classes havefree start times (start punching).

All other competitors have a 3 min call-up before their start time for checking the SI pin and taking the control definitions.

Zeroing of the SI pin occurs on the way to start.

Classes up to and including HD16 get the map one minute before the start time. The race starts on the start signal.

Other classes mayonly take the map at the start signal. The race starts on the start signal.

For stage 3, there is a chasing start for classesHD21, HD20 and HD18 based on the total time for stages 1 and 2. Competitorswith a difference to the leader of more than 30 minutes will be started at 30 second intervals.

Runners in classes HD21, HD20 and HD18 should white tape in the nature. wear the same number for stages 1 and 2.

Self-service at the start on day 1.

New numbers will be issued for stage 3 for the Finish punching takes place on the finish line. positions 1-15.

Self-services at the start on day 3.

Position 16 and up keep the same number from line. stages 1 and 2.

Terrain Type

Mainly forest.

On Stage 1 some areas of rocky gravel-ridge terrain.

Many small and large areas of marshland.

The area is crossed by a small gravel road, forest tracks and paths.

Climb

Moderate climb.

On Stages 2 and 3 there are flatter areas of runnable open rock.

Runnability

Available in EVENTOR and posted at the arena Generally good runnability. Vegetation is mainly coniferous forest of varying age. Limited areas of felled trees and thicker "fight" forest.

Taped paths

On some of the easier courses some paths have been cut through the vegetation and marked with white tape.

Maximum time

2.5 hours for all stages.

Broken competition

Competitors who fail to complete the course must pass the finish to be registered as having broken the race.
