Arena:	Storvreten, Tumba. (WG S84 59°11'2.8"N 17°51'44"E)
Parking/shower:	Harbrostugan, Tumba. Directions from road 226. (WG S84 59°11'53.0"N 17°51'33"E)
Classes:	According to Biathlon Orienteering rules. In case of few registered, classes can be merged. Open easy (yellow/orange), Open difficult (Violette/blue) In open classes shadow is allowed.

Weapon:	.22 long rifle
Gun Inspection:	08.30
Adjustment shooting:	09.00 -> at paper targets
First start:	11.00
Map:	Tumba-Tullinge. Partially updated 2018
Terrain	Forest with streaks of paths, clearings and walk ways. Moderately hilly with mostly good to very good run ability.
Weapon rent:	There are a limited number of rental weapons available.
Location Orienteering:	Ca 3 km, customized lane for MW10-14
Accommodation:	Flottsbro (flottsbro.com), Lida (lida.nu) or on hard surface in clubhouse "Harbro".
Banquet:	Common dinner with price giving ceremony at clubhouse "Harbro", Saturday evening. Dinner must be ordered in the entry.
Entry:	Through Eventor (press "all events, including local and club events) or mail to tess_eklov@hotmail.com, Until Friday August 9 th .
Fees:	Competition fee MW10-16, 120 SEK / day, all others 200 SEK / day. Accommodation in "Harbro" 50 SEK / person. Banquet MW10-16 135 SEK, all others 185 SEK. Late entry. Ordinary price +50% until August 15 th . Rent of weapon 50 SEK/day incl. ammunition. Rent of SportIdentbricka 25 SEK / day (if you don't return the SportIdent you will get an invoice of 500SEK
