

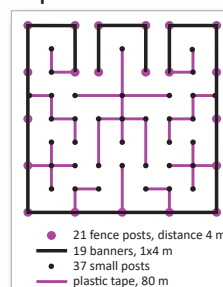
## PM: WORLD MAZE ORIENTEERING

Before the implementation of the first "World Maze Orienteering" ever, we want to highlight some things that every organiser should think about and consider. The recommendations of the Public Health Authority are still valid with regard to each country's situation. In addition, we recommend that you have access to disinfectant, among other things, in order to wash off EMIT tag or SI-stick which is lent out. We recommend that there are a maximum of 6 runners in the maze at the same time.

**TIME** Saturday May 30<sup>th</sup> 2020, between 10 AM-02 PM.

**LOCATION** Everywhere! All clubs around the world can join. In as many locations as possible. The goal for this year is 100 locations! Each club builds the maze in a suitable location where you can also promote the club's activities such as Permanent Course, Urban O-Race, School orienteering etc. A suitable location can be the main square, a park, a mall or the clubhouse.

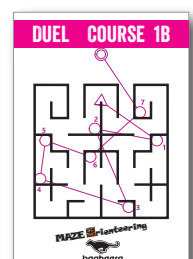
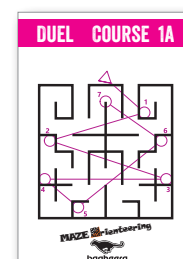
**MAZE/MASTERMAP** The maze is 16 x 16 m. It can be built with plastic strips secured to posts or other suitable pole. You can also build it with a fence or banners. Each sector in the maze is 2 m and it's this distance that determines the maze. The drawing below shows what the maze should look like and compare it with the maze pictures.



The START is placed edge to edge to the maze and the FINISH is 4 m from the maze (see training maps). Each control is placed in the corner, where the punching unit is 40 cm diagonally from the corner. Check out this video from Dalaportens' maze during "Avesta 100 years" last year:

**TRAINING COURSES** 5 training courses (green, blue, red, black and a duel). You will find all training courses at Eventor for downloading and printing (A4, A5 or A6). Duell courses folded together 1A/1B and 2A/2B. Laminate or plastic bag.



The training maps are borrowed by the runners and the courses can be run as often as you like.

**THE RACE COURSE** "Maze Race" (orange track) will be posted at Eventor on Friday May 29<sup>th</sup>, at the latest at 03:00 PM. You can run the Maze Race only once! The course consists of 13 controls, track length is 130 m, and the best route choice is 210 m. When printing, it is optional to fold part A with part B in A6 or in A5 or to print on both sides of A4. Laminate or plastic bag. The runners keep this map (if they want).

**THE WINNERS!** A winner "world wide" is selected in each class as follows:

- Youth, female and male (-16 år)
- Senior, female and male (17-35 år)
- Master, female and male (36-69 år)

**IMPLEMENTATION** We recommend that you alternate the training courses with the competition course. One variant is that you change every quarter, for example 00:00 Training courses, 00:15 Competition course, 00:30 Training courses, etc. Runners can start every 30 seconds. Only race runners in the maze at competition. We recommend that there are a maximum of 6 runners in the maze at the same time.

**STAFF** We recommend the following:  
At START: 2 people; one that keeps track of the runners before the start, one that sends the runners off.  
At FINISH: 3 people; one who reads the punching chip (2 time slots, runner's ex / report tag), one who writes name, class and possibly other club than the organiser club (eg school name) on the report tag, one who reports this information at Google Form. Centrally, there should be an "EVENT DIRECTOR" who can lead the work and jump in where needed. Feel free to provide additional information about the club's activities and the possibility of a speaker and some music playing ...

**TIME KEEPING/  
RACE COURSE** Each organiser chooses any method for time keeping/punching checking. It can be manual timing and manual punching (hand on the control stand) but we assume that all clubs run electronic punching for example EMIT/Sportident and time reding with a receipt printer.



**RESULT/  
RACE COURSE** Instructions for reporting results (via Google Form) will be posted at Eventor - internet connection required. Reported results are transferred to "Live results". This update occurs approximately every 10-15 minutes. The final result list will be linked from Eventor. NOTE! In the PM for your local competition it must be stated that those who want their results reported also allow the publication of names at Internet (GDPR).

**ENTRY FEE** We recommend that this activity is free of charge, but if you want to charge for each runner, the fee should be low, e.g. €20. The fee can be considered a lot as we draw many prizes from our partners Bagheera, Str8, EMIT and Letro Sport.

**SPECIAL PRIZE** A special prize is a map of the schoolyard with an associated photo orienteering. The map as well the exercises will be produced by Göran Andersson. Travel and accommodation expenses will be added. See examples from Smedby school in Hedemora.



## PRIZES

Prizes from our partners to the top 3 in each class as well as the draw among all starters. In addition, we draw some major prizes to the participant clubs. Examples of prizes are:

**ENTER/ PAYMENT** Each club reports its participation at Eventor (Swedish clubs) or via email (foreign clubs). Cost 500 SEK per club. The fee includes the book "Cool, Awesome and Educational" (value €20), lottery ticket to the winners (see prizes), maps and administration. The book will be sent to the respective organiser. The clubs are billed afterwards.

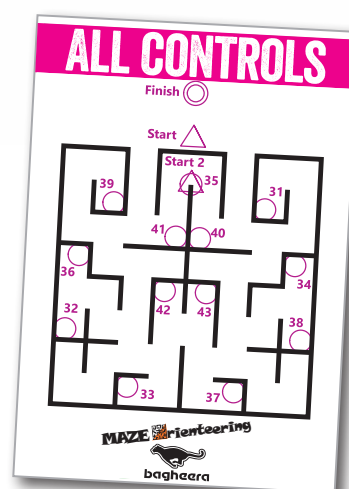
