Bus parking Buses are divided into the following two categories:

• Buses which only drop of the passenger and leaves the event centre during the day. The drop of place for these buses is approximately 400 m from the competition centre.

Hamn, get off at Östertälje station. From Östertälje station take the local bus 780 to Nykvarn (Sandtorp). Get off the bus at bus stop Almnäs crossroads (Almnäs vägskäl). Walk 3 km to the assembly
