WHAT IF 10MILA MUST CANCEL OR POSTPONE?

1.1. The 10mila association in joint consultation with this year's organizer – below called 10MILA – reserve the right to cancel or postpone one or several competitions/classes or change starting times.

1.1.1. due to circumstances beyond the control of 10MILA, comprising but not limited to actions or negligence by authorities, new or changed legislation, conflicts by labour market parties, blockades, fire, flood, other cataclysms or major accidents or

1.1.2. if 10MILA or authorities deem it necessary for your and/or other participants safety or health.

1.1.3. if the competition is not ratified by the Swedish Orienteering Association or if 10MILA is not given the permission by authorities necessary to perform the competitions

1.2. 10MILA has no obligation to reimburse registration fees or pay damages or other compensation if the total 10MILA event or one or several classes must be cancelled or postponed due to circumstances according to items 1.1.1 to 1.1.3 above, or other exceptional circumstances

1.3. In case the 10MILA, parts thereof or one or several competitions/classes are moved to another date the same year due to circumstances according to items 1.1.1 to 1.1.3 above, or other exceptional circumstances, the registration will be moved forward. 10MILA will as far as possible make changes to connected services such as accommodation, rental SI cards and if possible handle changes of team registrations.

1.4. In case 10MILA, parts thereof or one or several competitions/classes are cancelled due to circumstances according to items 1.1.1 to 1.1.3 above or other exceptional circumstances 10MILA aims to reimburse this year's registered clubs. The amount 10MILA will be able to repay will be based on the time of the cancelation and the amount burdening this year's event. Any decision on how much 10MILA shall reimburse and when this can be done will be made by the board of the Swedish Orienteering Association in joint consultation with the 10MILA board.
