
# **Sport sales**

## First aid Saturday-Sunday

The first aid services are offered mainly for the competitors and is manned by educated healthcare personnel; physicians included. A defibrillator is available and an ambulance is located nearby the arena.

There is also a medical area in the competition area, indicated on the map. All manned controls and water stations are equipped with first aid. There will be appropriate vehicles that can pick-up injured runners in the forest if needed.

If needed, always call 112 in case of emergency.

#### **Public Guest WiFi**

A public wireless network (WiFi) is available in the central parts of the arena area. The network name is "10MILA-Guest".

#### **Showers**

Showers are located outdoors. NB. The showers are located in an environmentally protected area.

Toilets are also available in the women's shower.

### **Toilets**

The toilets are marked on the arena map. Toilets are available to the north of the arena, at both wind shelter sites, and in connection to the showers/parking. At the north side of the arena, there is also a toilet for disabled.

Toilets are available in the changeover zone.

#### Waste

On the area, there are trash bins. Please sort as much as possible: food, cardboards, paper, glass, metal and regular waste.

Each club will receive a rubbish bag in the club bag containing the team envelopes. The rubbish bags can be thrown away at a disposal station situated along the walk to the parking/bus stop. Additional rubbish bags can be retrieved at the info centre.

Handling of waste is done in cooperation with Städa Sverige, Ragn-Sells and Örebro municipality.



#### Fire ban

It is absolutely forbidden to light fires at the arena and tent areas for safety reasons. Areas with residential tents are equipped with fire extinguishers on marked locations.
